TOURNAMENT SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE: The Tournament Committee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament, subject to the provisions of the Australian Ranking Tournament Rules and Regulations. Any matter not specifically covered in the applicable tournament rules and regulations shall be resolved by the Committee members present, whose decision shall be final.

ELIGIBILITY: All entrants (including overseas players) must be currently registered with an Australian State/Territory Association and must have a valid 11-digit My Tennis Player ID number. Players who are not so registered will be registered with Tennis Queensland at no extra charge as a UQ Tennis Club Restricted Member. To receive National Seniors Ranking Points, entrants in Seniors events must be members of Tennis Seniors Queensland or, if from inter-state, must be members of their State's Seniors association. Entrants in Seniors events who are not TSQ members may include a payment of \$20 for TSQ membership with their entry.

AGE EVENT ELIGIBILITY: Entrants in Age events must supply their birth dates and produce their birth certificates if requested. Eligibility for Junior events is based on the player's age as at 31 July 2019 (i.e. 18 & Under – born 1 August 2000 or later). Senior events are open to players who reach the relevant age at any time during the year of the tournament or earlier (i.e. 35 & Over – born 1984 or earlier; 40 & Over – born 1979 or earlier; 45 & Over – born 1974 or earlier; 50 & Over – born 1969 or earlier; 55 & Over – born 1964 or earlier; 60 & Over – born 1959 or earlier).

GRADE EVENT ELIGIBILITY: The listed Fixture grade cut-offs for Round-Robin Grade events are approximate only. Fixture players are required to disclose all relevant information about their current Fixtures (organising bodies, competitions, seasons, team names & grades) and their ITN (if known). Grade event entries without this information may not be accepted. Where partners in Grade Doubles events are of different standards, event eligibility shall be decided on the basis of the higher standard. The Committee reserves the right to transfer a player to a higher level event if it deems the player to be above the designated standard for the level entered and is not required to give a reason or to advise the player beforehand. If a player is found to have been allowed to play in too low a Grade event because of undisclosed or false information about Fixture grades, that player may be defaulted. ENTRIES: Entries must be lodged with all fees by 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, 6 July; except that a postal entry for non AR ranking events received after this date, but prior to the event draw being completed, shall be accepted provided it bears a postmark of Friday, 5 July, or earlier.

Entries for the Australian Ranking Points events may only be lodged on-line at <https://tournaments.tennis.com.au> with credit card payment. Entries for all other events may be lodged on-line with credit card payment or by using the printed entry form which can be downloaded from <https://www.uqtc.org.au>. Printed entry forms may be lodged by hand delivery, by post (with cheque, money order or credit card payment authority) or as an attachment by e-mail to tournaments@uqtc.org.au (with credit card payment authority). Payments for all events may also be made by Internet Banking directly into the UQ Tennis Club's bank account [Bank: Commonwealth; BSB: 06 4158; Account Name: University of Queensland Tennis Club; Account No.: 0090 0066]. Such payments must be clearly identified with the player's name and must be notified by e-mail to the Tournament Director. Entries lodged without payment will not be included in the draw.

No player shall be permitted to enter in more than three events without the express permission of the Tournament Committee; and if entered in three events, one must be a Doubles.

Players should check on-line that their entries have been received and to verify the events in which they are entered (at <https://tournaments.tennis.com.au>).

ENTRY FEES: Refer to the List of Events for Entry Fees. The Entry Fees listed are 'per person' and include GST and Tennis Queensland Sanction Fees. Fees listed if entering on-line include the additional Stripe & Tennis Australia on-line processing fees. Where any full or partial entry fee refunds are due for on-line payments, the refund will be calculated excluding any Stripe & Tennis Australia processing fees.

WITHDRAWALS: Players who withdraw from an event after 11:59 p.m. on Friday 12 July, or withdraw from an event during the tournament, may be penalised under the TA Code of Behaviour. Withdrawal notification must be in writing (by e-mail, fax or post but not by SMS or social media).

TIME EXEMPTIONS: Players must be available at all times during the tournament. Any time exemption requests will be ignored*. The Tournament Time Draw cannot be organised around players other activities. * *Notwithstanding this, requests for time exemptions because of GPS or QGSSSA Tennis may be considered but only if such requests are made at the time of entry (as Remarks under "Extra Items & Remarks"). Players requesting such a time exemption may be restricted to entering just one event and should check with the Tournament Director before entering.*

MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENT: For an event to be conducted, a minimum of four entries will generally be required. Where there are less than four entries, the event may be cancelled and entrants given the option of transferring to another event or receiving a refund.

AUSTRALIAN RANKING POINTS EVENT FORMATS: There will be no qualifying rounds for the AMT (Open) Men's Singles, AMT (Open) Ladies' Singles, 18 & Under Boys' Singles and 18 & Under Girls' Singles with each of these events being conducted as a single open draw.

CONSOLATIONS & PLAY-OFFS: The AMT (Open) Men's Singles, AMT (Open) Ladies' Singles, 18 & Under Boys' Singles & 18 & Under Girls' Singles have SIGN-ON OPTIONAL Consolation events. For a 16-player draw, the first round losers only will be eligible for the Consolation. For 24-player, 32-player, 48-player and 64-player draws, the first and second round losers will be eligible for the Consolation. For 96-player & above draws, the first, second & third round losers will be eligible for the Consolation. Eligible players for a Consolation have until 5 minutes after the conclusion of the last match in the relevant round of the main draw to sign on at the Tournament Office for the Consolation. Only those who sign on for the Consolation will be drawn to play. Each Consolation will be a new knock-out draw. In the 18 & Under Boys' Singles & 18 & Under Girls' Singles, the losing Semi-Finalists are required to play-off for 3rd and 4th positions.

There are no Doubles Consolation events.

COURT SURFACES: Open, 18 & Under and Special events will be played on hardcourts (Laykold) and cushioned hardcourts (Laykold Cushion). Seniors events will be played on synthetic grass courts and hardcourts & cushioned hardcourts as there are only 2 synthetic grass courts at UQ. Other events may be played on hardcourts, cushioned hardcourts or synthetic grass courts.

MATCHES: Events 1-2 & 10-11 shall be played using the Knock-Out format and all matches shall be the best-of-three tie-break sets. Events 3-5, 6-9 & 12-14 and all consolation matches shall be played using the Knock-Out format and all matches shall be two tie-break sets but, if the score reaches one set all, the match will be decided by a match tie-break (10 points)]. In Events 3-5, 8-9 & 12-14, No-Ad scoring will be used. In any set, if the score reaches six games all, a tie-break game shall be played to determine the winner of the set.

Events 15 to 46 shall be played using Round-Robin formats. Depending on numbers, players in each event will be split into groups with group winners going on to compete in play-offs to determine the event winner. Match lengths will be determined by the Committee prior to play starting but would normally be one first-to-six-games set with a tie-break at five-all or a first-to-nine-games set with a tie-break at eight-all.

In all events, matches may be scheduled to be played or completed under lights. Depending on entry numbers, some event formats may differ from those advertised.

DOUBLES: All Doubles pairs must enter by 6 July. Where a player enters a Doubles event without nominating a partner or where the nominated partner does not enter that event, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to pair such players as per the procedures outlined in the Australian Ranking Tournament Rules and Regulations or to take additional sign-on entries but only to complete a pair.

DRAW AVAILABILITY: It is each player's responsibility to ascertain the time draw and to be in attendance at the courts at the time(s) set down. For each weekend of play, the time draw should be available on-line by the preceding Wednesday. The Tournament Committee will endeavour to notify players about their definite match times and possible follow-on match times in each event by e-mail but players can check match times on-line at <https://tournaments.tennis.com.au>.

CHECK-IN & NO-SHOWS: Each player should report to the Tournament Office and have his/her name checked off as being present at least 15 minutes before the scheduled time of each match (or session start time for round-robin events). Any player not ready to play or refusing to play within 15 minutes of his/her match being called may be defaulted. A player defaulted as a "No-Show" may be permitted to play in other events, including consolations, at the discretion of the Referee provided the player contacts the Tournament Office within one hour of the time scheduled for the match. All other players defaulted as a "No Show" will be taken out of all other events in the tournament, including consolations.

BALLS: The HEAD Tour Tennis ball will be used in this tournament..

SCORECARDS: A completed scorecard must be returned to the Tournament Office for a match result to be credited. All players in a match are responsible for checking their own results are correct on the scorecard before it is lodged as, once lodged, the result is unlikely to be changed if later disputed.

ON-LINE RESULTS: It is a condition of entry that players agree to allow the Tournament Committee to publish results (including names and scores) on the Tennis Australia Tournaments Website (<https://tournaments.tennis.com.au>).

PRIZEMONEY & REFUNDS: Payment of prizemoney and refunds will be by internet bank transfer. Players winning prizemoney or eligible for a refund must provide full bank account details to receive payment (i.e. name of bank, BSB, account number and account name).

JUNIOR PLAYERS: Tournament Officials are not able to supervise children (i.e. persons under 18 years of age) playing in this Tournament. Entries from juniors are only accepted on the understanding that the supervision and protection of children during their participation in the University Open Tennis Championships is the responsibility of their parents/guardians and not the Tournament Committee and other Tournament Officials.

TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS: By signing acceptance of the entry conditions when using the printed entry form, participants (or parents/guardians for junior entrants) acknowledge and agree that all Tennis Australia policies, including the Standard Tournament Entry Conditions, can be readily viewed at <https://www.tennis.com.au> and that it is their responsibility to view these and seek clarification, if required, from the Tennis Australia Tournaments Department AND agree to comply with and be bound by the Tournament Specific Conditions above, the Tennis Australia Standard Tournament Entry Conditions and any other policies, rules, procedures or regulations of Tennis Australia relevant to tournaments sanctioned by Tennis Australia.
