

2025 UQ STUDENT & STAFF TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

This is not an open tournament. It is being conducted by UQ Sport Ltd and The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (UQ Tennis Club) for the students and staff of The University of Queensland (UQ).

Entrants must be members of the UQ Tennis Club but players who are not Paid Members (Ordinary, Associate or Junior) will pay a higher entry fee to become Restricted Members of the UQ Tennis Club to enable them to enter.

When entering, Restricted Members must pay the Restricted Member Extra Entry Fee of \$5.16 (listed under Extras) as well as the Event Entry Fee of \$36.09.

Note: When players go to enter on-line, they are asked to log-in using their Tennis Australia Competitive Player Profile log-in. Players can check if they have a Tennis ID & Competitive Player Profile or they can create a Competitive Player Profile & Tennis ID & UTR link by going to:

Anybody who has a problem logging in, or entering events once logged in, should contact Tennis Australia via play@tennis.com.au or Ph 1800 752 983.

All entrants in the Student events must be enrolled in a degree, diploma or certificate course at The University of Queensland in 2025 (any UQ campus; undergraduate or postgraduate; full-time or part-time; internal or external) and have a UQ Student Number and UQ Student Card.

All entrants in the Staff events must be academic or general staff of The University of Queensland in 2025 (any UQ campus; full-time, part-time or casual) and have a UQ Staff Number and a UQ Staff Card.

This is a daytime tournament, with play commencing each day at 8 a.m. The Student events will consist of a Round-Robin Qualifying event on 7 September, if needed, with a Knock-Out Main Draw on 13 & 14 September. The Staff events will be played using Round-Robin formats on 7 September. There are no consolation events.

On-Line entrants in Student events must supply, under "Remarks", their UQ Student Number, UQ course details (degree, diploma or certificate & campus) and information about any rankings, ratings (UTR) or Fixtures (Competition, Team, Grade). Players who do not supply this information may be excluded from the draw.

On-Line entrants in Staff events must supply, under "Remarks", their UQ Staff Number and employment details (position, school/department/section & campus) and information about any rankings, ratings (UTR) or Fixtures (Competition, Team, Grade). Players who do not supply this information may be excluded from the draw.

It is each player's responsibility to ascertain their time draw and to be in attendance at the courts at the time(s) set down. The Tournament Committee will endeavour to notify players about their definite match times and possible follow-on match times in each event by e-mail but players can check draws and match times on-line. The Time Draw should be available on-line by the Wednesday before each weekend of play.

2025 UQ STUDENT & STAFF TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. This tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the Game adopted by Tennis Australia, the Tournament Rules & Regulations laid down by Tennis Queensland, the Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour and the UQ Tennis Club Code of Conduct.
2. This tournament is being conducted by UQ Sport Ltd and The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (UQ Tennis Club).
3. The Tournament Management Committee shall have the entire control and management of the tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these Conditions shall be resolved by the Committee members present, whose decision shall be final.
4. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event; to postpone any event to such time and date as it considers suitable; to abandon any match; to use any type of court surface; to vary the length of a match from that advertised; and to schedule or complete matches under lights.
5. Entry is restricted to players who are current members of the UQ Tennis Club. To make them eligible for entry, players who are not Full Members of the Club (i.e. Ordinary, Associate, Junior or Hon. Life Members) or Restricted Members will be granted Restricted Membership of the Club by paying a higher entry fee which includes free registration with Tennis Queensland. For such persons, lodgement of this signed entry form will be deemed to be an application for such membership and agreement to be bound by the rules & regulations of the UQ Tennis Club.
6. All entrants must have a Tennis Australia Competitive Player Profile linked to Universal Tennis Ratings and must supply their Tennis ID.
7. Entry in Student events is restricted to current students of The University of Queensland (UQ). 'Current Student' means a person who is enrolled at any time during 2025 in a degree, diploma or certificate course (undergraduate or postgraduate; full-time, part-time or external) at any UQ campus and has a UQ Student Number and UQ Student ID Card. Entrants in Student events must provide, under "Remarks", their UQ Student Number and details of the course enrolled in and campus where studying and produce their UQ Student ID Card if required. Entry in Staff events is restricted to current staff of UQ. 'Current Staff' means a person employed by UQ at any time during 2025 as academic or general staff on a full-time, part-time or casual basis at

any UQ campus and has a UQ Staff Number and UQ Staff ID Card. Entrants in Staff events must provide, under "Remarks", their UQ Staff Number and details of the school, section and campus where employed and produce their UQ Staff ID Card if required. Entrants who do not supply the information requested to confirm their status as students and/or staff may be excluded from the draw.

8. This is a daytime tournament which will be played on Sunday 7 September, Saturday 13 September and Sunday 14 September, but may be extended to following weekends if necessary to complete an event. Players must be available on 7, 13 & 14 as required. The tournament time draw cannot be organised around players' other activities. Although events are pre-scheduled for particular days, events can be scheduled at other times if weather conditions preclude or interrupt play on the designated day(s).
9. Entries must be lodged on-line. All entries must be lodged with the entry fees by 11:55 p.m. on Sunday, 31 August, 2025 (fees listed for on-line entry include the Stripe & Tennis Australia on-line processing fees). Entry fees may also be paid by direct deposit into the Club's bank account [*Bank: Commonwealth; BSB: 06 4158; Account No.: 0090 0066; Account Name: University of Queensland Tennis Club*].
10. All entries will be confirmed by e-mail where an e-mail address is supplied. Players who do not receive such confirmation by 5 p.m. on Monday 1 September should contact the Tournament Director (Ph 0409 090 299, E-Mail tournaments@uqtc.org.au). Receipt of entries can be checked on-line at <https://tournaments.tennis.com.au>.
11. Any player may withdraw by the designated withdrawal deadline and the entry fee less a \$5 administration fee shall be refunded. No entry fees shall be refunded where a player is defaulted or where a player is a no-show or withdraws after the withdrawal deadline.
12. Players must enter the event(s) specific for their gender. Players who are eligible for Student and Staff events may enter both events.
13. For an event to be conducted, a minimum of 4 entries will usually be required. Where an event is cancelled, entrants will receive a full refund (less any on-line processing fees for on-line entrants).
14. Qualifying events will be conducted for the UQ Student events where the draw exceeds 8 entries. Where a Qualifying is used, there will be up to 6 direct acceptances into the Main Draw (as selected by the Committee) with the remaining players competing in the Qualifying (on 7 September) for the final positions in the 8-player Main Draw (to be played on 13 & 14 September). Qualifying events will be conducted using a Round-Robin format. Main Draw events will be conducted using a Knock-Out format. There will be no consolation events.
15. Staff events will be conducted using a Round-Robin format. The Staff Ladies' Singles and the Staff Men's Singles will be played on Sunday, 7 September.
16. In all Student Singles Main Draw events, matches shall be the best-of-two tie-break sets [i.e. if the score reaches one set all, a match deciding tie-break (10 points) shall be played]. In any set, if the score reaches 6 games all, a tie-break game shall be played to determine the winner of the set. A warm-up period of 5 minutes shall be permitted prior to the commencement of each match. Play shall be continuous from the first service until the match is concluded; except that after the second set in a three-set match, a player shall be entitled to a rest which shall not exceed 5 minutes.
17. In all Student Qualifying events and Staff events, matches will be played using Round-Robin formats. Depending on numbers, players in each event may be split into groups with group winners going on to compete in play-offs to determine the event winner. Match lengths will be determined by the Committee prior to play starting but would normally be one first-to-six-

games set with a tie-break at five-all.

18. For each Student event, the winner and runner-up will receive a trophy and prizemoney (Winner \$150 and Runner-Up \$75). However, the Committee reserves the right to reduce the amount of prizemoney depending on the number of players, according to the following schedule: 16 players or more – 100%; 8-15 players – 75%; 7 players or less – 50%. For each Staff event, the winner and runner-up will receive a trophy. No prizemoney will be paid where a player is defaulted, where a player withdraws or where a player is a no-show.
19. Where an e-mail address is supplied, players should be notified of their match times by e-mail a few days prior to each day of the tournament. However, as match times can be checked on-line at <https://tournaments.tennis.com.au> and by contacting the Tournament Director, it is the player's responsibility to ascertain the draw and to be in attendance at the courts at the times set down.
20. Once matches are drawn, times will not be changed unless the Committee has made an error.
21. **All players must report to the Tournament Office 15 minutes before the scheduled time of each of their matches.** Any player not ready to play or refusing to play within 15 minutes of the match being called may be defaulted.
22. Where a player is scheduled for more than one best-of-two-sets match in a day, that player shall be entitled to a break of 30 minutes between matches. In Round-Robin events, where matches are just one set, players are entitled to a break of 10 minutes between matches.
23. Entrants agree to allow the Committee to publish the event results (including names and scores) on the UQ Tennis Club Website (<https://www.uqtc.org.au>) & Facebook Page (<https://www.facebook.com/uqtennis>) and Tennis Australia's Tournaments Website (<https://tournaments.tennis.com.au>) and to provide the results to UTR Sports for calculation of UTRs and publication on the UTR Website (<http://www.utrsports.net>).
24. Entrants agree to allow the Committee to have photographs, motion pictures and videotapes taken of them during the tournament and assign to the UQ Tennis Club the right in perpetuity to use such material in any way without any remuneration (including, but not limited to, publishing in newsletters and on websites and social media platforms).
25. Completion of the on-line entry process is deemed to be confirmation of the acceptance of the Condition of Entry.
