2020 FASTENNIS SINGLES CHALLENGE TOURNAMENT - CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This tournament is approved by Tennis Queensland and shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of the Game adopted by Tennis Australia (except as varied herein), the Tournament Rules & Regulations laid down by Tennis Queensland, the Tennis Australia Code of Behaviour and the UQ Tennis Club Code of Conduct.
- 2. This is a close tournament being conducted by The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (UQ Tennis Club) and entry is restricted to players who are current members of the UQ Tennis Club. Players who are not Full Members of the Club (i.e. Ordinary, Associate, Junior or Hon. Life Members) or Restricted Members will be granted free Restricted Membership (Tournament Player category) to make them eligible for entry and, for such persons, lodgement of this signed entry form will be deemed to be an application for such membership and agreement to be bound by the rules & regulations of the UQ Tennis Club. Restricted Members will pay a higher entry fee than Full Members.
- 3. This tournament is a Category A Tournament in the 2020 UQ Tennis Club Grand Prix. Only Full Members receive points in the Grand Prix.
- 4. The Tournament Management Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "Committee", shall have the entire control and management of the tournament. Any matter not specifically covered by these Conditions shall be resolved by the Committee members present, whose decision shall be final.
- 5. Entries must be submitted on the prescribed entry form or lodged on-line. Where players use the printed entry form, the entry form must be completed in full, signed to confirm acceptance of the Tournament Conditions and lodged with the entry fees by the designated closing date (i.e. by 11:59 p.m. on Thursday, 27 February). Depending on how the entry is lodged, payment may be made by Cash, Cheque, Money Order, Credit Card (MasterCard, Visa Card or American Express only) or Debit Card. If paying by cheque or money order, make payable to The University of Queensland Tennis Club Inc. (or UQ Tennis Club). Entries must be sent to the UQ Tennis Club. Entries may be hand delivered; posted to the UQ Tennis Club, PO Box 6005, St Lucia, Qld 4067; scanned and e-mailed to tournaments@uqtc.org.au (with credit card payment); or lodged online with credit card payment at https://tournaments.tennis.com.au (fees listed for on-line entry include the Stripe & Tennis Australia on-line processing fee). Entry fees may also be paid by direct deposit into the Club's bank account [Bank: Commonwealth; BSB: 06 4158; Account No.: 0090 0066; Account Name: University of Queensland Tennis Club].
- 6. Because of the limitation on the number of players that can be accommodated at the UQ Sport Tennis Centre in a one-morning tournament, the Tournament Director (at his/her sole discretion) may close entries early and/or cap the number of entries to be accepted to ensure the tournament can be played to completion in the time available.
- 7. All entries will be confirmed by e-mail after close of entries where an e-mail address is supplied. Players who do not receive such confirmation by 5 p.m. on Thursday 5 March should contact the Tournament Director (Ph 0409 090 299, E-Mail tournaments@uqtc.org.au). Players who believe they have entered, but do not receive confirmation, have no claim on a position in the draw unless they contact the Tournament Director by 1 p.m. on Saturday 7 March. Receipt of entries can be checked on-line at https://tournaments.tennis.com.au.
- 8. Any player may withdraw prior to the draw being made and the entry fee less relevant administrative expenses shall be refunded. No entry fees shall be refunded where a player is defaulted or where a player withdraws after being placed in the draw and the courts booked.
- 9. Players of all standards and genders will compete in a single event; although the Committee reserves the right to divide players into groups, depending on entry numbers, with play-offs between the group winners to determine over-all winners.
- 10. The event will be played using a consolation draw format (such as the Continuous Feed-In Draw, Continuous Play Draw or Feed-In Championship Draw) which guarantees that all entrants get multiple matches because players go into consolation rounds when they lose. Round-Robins may also be used for some of the later play-offs. The exact format will be decided by the Committee when the entry numbers are known.
- 11. Each match shall consist of one set but players shall be permitted a warm-up period of 3 minutes prior to their first set only.
- 12. Each set in the main draw shall be played using the FASTENNIS format in which the set is won by the player who is first to win 21 points. Players serve in rotation with each server getting 5 serves, starting to the first court. Players change ends after 10 points. There is a sudden-death point if the score reaches 20-all. For the sudden-death point, the server next in order to serve, serves the point but the receiver gets to choose the side. For consolation matches, modified FASTENNIS formats shall be used where the set is won by the player who is first to win 16 points (with a sudden-death point if the score reaches 15-all) or where the set is won by the player who is first to win 11 points (with a sudden-death point if the score reaches 10-all).
- 13. Although the tournament will be played as a single draw, prizes will be awarded for the best performed male and female players of the following standard Open (equivalent to ITN 4 or above), A Grade (equivalent to ITN 5), B Grade (equivalent to ITN 6) and C Grade (equivalent to ITN 7 or lower); although the Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of levels depending on entry numbers. Provisional ITNs (International Tennis Numbers) will be assigned by the Committee on the basis of previous Fixture results, grading sessions and current Fixture grades.
- 14. All players must report to the Tournament Office at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of play (i.e. by 7:45 a.m.). Entrants not ready to play at 8 a.m. may be defaulted. Play will be scheduled to finish before the start of Social Tennis at 2 p.m. but, if necessary to complete the tournament, play may be extended later into the afternoon.
- 15. In the event of rain preventing or interrupting play on Sunday 8 March, the tournament will be played or completed on Sunday morning, 15 March, unless notified otherwise.
- 16. Entrants agree to allow the Committee to publish the tournament results (including names and scores) on the Tennis Australia Tournaments Website (https://tournaments.tennis.com.au).
- 17. Entries from players under 18 years of age are only accepted on the understanding that the supervision and protection of juniors during their participation in this tournament is the responsibility of their parents/guardians and not the Committee and Tournament Organizers.
- 18. Entrants agree to allow the Committee to have photographs, motion pictures and videotapes taken of them during the tournament and assign to the UQ Tennis Club the right in perpetuity to use such material in any way without any remuneration (including, but not limited to, publishing in newsletters and on websites and social media).
