EKKA SINGLES TOURNAMENT

The next tournament in the Club Tournament Program is the **Ekka Singles Challenge Tournament**.

The Ekka Singles will be played in the morning on the Exhibition Holiday (Wednesday, 14 August).

Entries close this Thursday, 8 August.

In this tournament, all players (male & female) will go into a single draw but players will drop into consolation rounds whenever they lose and keep playing throughout the morning. This means there may be some mis-matches in the early rounds but players will progress through the draws to meet players of their own standard and will get lots of matches.

Entrants in the Ekka Singles must be Club Members but non-members will be given free Restricted Membership so they can enter. Entry fees for Restricted Members (\$35) are higher than for Ordinary, Associate & Junior Members (\$30).

As everybody goes into a single draw initially, players do not need to know their player rating or Fixtures grade to enter this tournament.

Entries can be lodged on-line through the Tennis Australia Tournaments Website here.

N.B. When players go to enter on-line, they are asked to create a Tournament account if they don't already have one. To create a Tournament account, players need their 11-digit Tennis Australia My Tennis Player ID Number. Unfortunately, although the TA tournament on-line entry system still requires the 11-digit Player ID Number, Tennis Australia has stopped issuing Player ID Numbers automatically for new players being registered through My Tennis (as it is switching to using player e-

mail addresses for identification purposes). This means that players who do not have a Player ID Number, or don't remember their number, need to contact Tennis Australia via play@tennis.com.au or 1800 752 983 to obtain their number or have a number created for them (information required - name, postal address, unique e-mail address, birthdate and a phone number).

UQ STUDENT & STAFF TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

The **2019 UQ Student & Staff Tennis Championships** will be played on 14, 17 & 18 August.

Entries close this Thursday, 8 August.

Entry in this tournament is restricted to current students and staff of The University of Queensland. Entrants must also be Club Members but non-members will be given free Restricted Membership so they can enter. Entry fees for Restricted Members (\$35) are higher than for Ordinary, Associate & Junior Members (\$30).

The tournament will consist of four events:

UQ Student Men's Singles (round-robin qualifying with knock-out main draw)
UQ Student Ladies' Singles (round-robin qualifying with knock-out main draw)
UQ Staff Men's Singles (round-robin)
UQ Staff Ladies' Singles (round-robin)

Entrants will be competing for over \$600 in prizemoney and trophies - Prizemoney & trophies for the Student events and trophies for the Staff events.

The main Draw of the UQ Student Men's Singles and UQ Student Ladies' Singles will be played using a Knock-Out format on 17 & 18 August with a Qualifying Round-Robin, if needed, on 14 August (in the afternoon, after the Ekka Singles Tournament).

The UQ Staff events will be played using Round-Robin formats on Sunday 18 August.

The Student Singles Champions become the holders of the **Reginald Roe Shield** which is named in honour of 'The Skipper', Reginald Heber Roe, who was Headmaster of Brisbane Grammar School for 30 years, one of the driving forces behind the establishment of The University of Queensland, the first Vice-Chancellor of The University of Queensland, the first President of UQ Sport and the founding father of Tennis in Queensland.

The Staff Singles Champions become the holders of the Mall Molesworth Shield which is named in honour of Brisbane's Maud Margaret (Mall) Molesworth who won the inaugural Australian Open Ladies' Singles Championships (in 1922), won the Queensland Open Ladies' Singles Championships 8 times (in 1922, 1923, 1924, 1927, 1929, 1930, 1931 & 1933), was the first Australian woman to be ranked in the World Top Ten and also coached the UQ Women's Intervarsity Team when her husband was teaching at UQ
